1 General considerations

1.1 Specified waste management operations

1.1.1 No waste management operations shall be authorised by this licence unless:

- a** specified in and undertaken in accordance with the limitations in the following Table 1.1; or
- b** otherwise required by the conditions of this licence as being an integral part of those operations:

1.2 Permitted wastes

Permitted categories and types of wastes

1.2.1 No wastes other than those which are categorised in Table 1.1 shall be accepted at the site.

Permitted quantities of wastes

1.2.2 The quantities of wastes accepted shall not exceed those listed in Table 1.2. Whilst complying with the maximum quantities specified for each specified waste management operation, the total quantity of waste accepted at the site per year shall not exceed 150,000 tonnes. The maximum storage capacities and maximum storage times shall not exceed those listed in Table 1.2.
