Charges

In accordance with the terms of the Waste Licence issued by the Environmental Protection Agency, only private vehicles bringing waste from households can enter the Civic Recycling Facility. Commercial vehicles and large vans (i.e. transit vans) and large trailers, will not be allowed entry. Some of the materials listed in the main CRF area are chargeable as follows:

 Cars (including estate cars & people carriers)	€12
 Small vans, 4 wheel drives, car vans and small trailer up to 1.5m ³ e.g. 1.8m x 1.2m with low sides	€20
 Intermediate vans and intermediate trailers up to 3m ³ e.g. 2.4m x 1.8m with low sides	€50

BALLYOGAN RECYCLING PARK CIVIC RECYCLING FACILITY (CRF)

What is the CRF?

The CRF is a Dun Laoghaire Rathdown County Council custom built site where householders can bring a wide range of materials for recycling or disposal where necessary. The CRF is operated and managed by **greenstar**, a private waste management company.

How do you use the CRF?

There is a separate container or skip for each type of material at the CRF, all materials must be segregated. Remember that wet or dirty material can contaminate other dry recyclables, when this happens nothing can be recycled and the whole load has to be sent to landfill for disposal. Materials such as metals, wood and green waste can be recycled and reused if collected separately.

Points to remember:

- Recyclables should be as clean & dry as possible.
- Rinse out all remaining foods & liquids.
- Flatten or squash boxes, cartons and cans.
- Remove plastic packaging from cardboard & paper.
- Check that your plastic containers are recyclable (examples on next page), plastic bottle tops can be left on.
- Make sure you put the correct material in each container.
